Activities on the World AIDS Orphans Day

On May 24th, Chi Heng Beijing Office, cooperating with Scope International (China) Co. Ltd, held the "AIDS Awareness Talk" in Beijing with more than 60 delegates. They learned about AIDS/HIV through role plays and interaction games. This year marks the 15th anniversary of the "Living with HIV" global programme that was initiated by Standard Chartered. They will further co-operate with Chi Heng for raising public awareness on AIDS/HIV.



In the afternoon on May 10th, Mr. Chung To paid a visit to the MBA Charity Group of Tsinghua University School of Economics and Management and held a public speech on two main themes; one was his own reflection on "the change from commercial sector to charity work", and the other was on "the successful integration of charity work and business models through enterprise social responsibility". Mr. To shared his 16 years of experience of charity work and discussed in depth with the students new models of charity work.

From May 5th to 6th, Chi Heng Beijing Office, together with Beijing University Health Science Centre, Minzu University of China and Tsinghua University, held an Exhibition of Paintings by AIDS orphans, which received considerable attention. College students wrote down their sincere blessings to the little starfish of Chi Heng, as World AIDS Orphans Day was approaching, making their own contribution to arouse social awareness of the situation faced by AIDS orphans.



On May 9th, Chi Heng Beijing Office, cooperating with Ingersoll Rand (China) Investment Co. Ltd., held an activity aimed at sharing knowledge of AIDS and eliminating discrimination. Besides hiking, the participants provided information about AIDS to the tourists and gathered greetings and blessings through little quizzes on facts about AIDS and displaying paintings done by AIDS-impacted children. ing, they demonstrated their care and consideration to AIDS-impacted people with their own actions.

With the support from their parents, these children will become more confident and they will eventually possess the courage to face the reality and surmount difficulties.



From May 31st to June 1st, Chi Heng Zhumadian Office held a two-day summer camp for Children's Day. 34 Chi Heng-sponsored children took part. During the camp, they joined the painting competition held by the Municipal Bureau of Education. They watched a 3D-movie for the first time and engaged in a variety of amusing games in the park, enjoying the warmth and care from each other. "I had a really great time here," said a shy little child, "my family seldom had time playing with me and I enjoy staying with these friends so much that I even don't want to go home!"

From May 30th to the afternoon on June 2nd, to celebrate Children's Day and the Dragon Boat Festival with the AIDS-impacted children, Chi Heng Zhoukou Office held a special activity for them. 30 Chi Heng-sponsored primary and middle school students participated in this activity. They visited Zhongyuan Culture and Art University and SIAS International University, experiencing life on a college campus. Visits to Zhengzhou Science and Technology Museum and other places of interests stimulated their curiosity in natural sciences. These entertaining yet inspiring events nurtured an optimistic attitude towards life as well as creation and innovation.

Chi Heng Distributing Stipends for School Fees to Students in Central China

The distribution of stipends for school fees of the school year 2013-2014 started from the end of April through the end of May. There were 1115 students in total receiving the stipends in the Henan, Shandong and Hubei Provinces. The stipends guaranteed a year of schooling for these students.

From May 12th to 30th, Chi Heng Yunnan Office distributed stipends to more than 1700 students from south west China. In addition, communication equipment and Dumex milk powder was also distributed to the indigent families so that they could overcome their difficulties brought by poverty. Through distributing stipends and necessities, the bond between Chi Heng and the sponsored families was strengthened and students were encouraged to continue their education.



On May 18th, Mr. Chung To distributed stipends for school fees and living expenses to 88 Senior 3 students. Among those present, there were two delegates from BOC International and the head of China Charity Federation, Ms. Duan. They encouraged the students to face the upcoming examinations with ease and optimism. Staff members of Chi Heng Guangzhou Office also arranged a special lecture for the students on tackling examinations and college applications, in an attempt to reduce their pressure.
