Activities on the 26th Annual World AIDS Day

On December 1st, campus publicity and charity sales were jointly held by Chi Heng Zhengzhou office with Zhengzhou SIAS International University, Zhengzhou Electrical Technology College and Northwest A&F University. This activity was aimed at raising awareness of college students on AIDS and AIDS orphans. Many students were inspired to become volunteers of Chi Heng. The net proceeds from charity sales will be used for the Education Sponsorship Program of AIDS Orphans.



On December 1st, Fuyang Broadcasting and TV Station filmed a publicity campaign about AIDS. The campaign was held jointly by Chi Heng Fuyang office, Fuyang Teachers College, and Fuyang CDC. This was the first time that Chi Heng was interviewed by the mainstream media in Fuyang. An appeal was made to the society to raise awareness of AIDS and eliminate discrimination of AIDS carriers.

22 young AIDS carriers attended a gathering called "I Am Not Alone Because Of You" held by the Chi Heng Shanghai office. These young people, mostly new in the workforce, talked about their jobs and emotional issues, and shared their own experiences. Through the gathering, they became friends who would support each other in the future.

26 child carriers, sponsored by Chi Heng Zhumadian office, participated in a mini winter camp called "Love for Everyone" on World AIDS Day. It was the first time for the young campers to taste western food, watch 3D movie, and have a picnic meal in the park. The volunteers donated seventy new winter coats which brought love to the children.



Chi Heng Helps Establish Two Reading Rooms in Yunnan

On December 22nd, two reading rooms, sponsored by Qualcomm, were opened in two elementary schools in Lincang. Due to the remote location, the Lincang students can hardly read extracurricular books. These 1800 books newly added in the reading rooms can help the students to widen their scope. Chi Heng also helps the schools in scientific library management to improve teaching standards.



Chi Heng Fuyang office held counseling to HIV positive students

Chi Heng Fuyang office offered counseling to 14 HIV positive students to help them further understand AIDS. Chi Heng helped them to build confidence, their value system, and the correct attitude in their lives and made them understand that they are not abandoned by society.

On November 30th, Chi Heng Yunnan office organized a cake-making class in Lincang. The aim of this activity was to teach children some basic cooking skills so they can help their parents at home.

In the evening of December 5th, the Chi Heng Beijing team came to Qinghua University for the 28th annual International Volunteer Day. Together with two volunteers, they shared their volunteering experiences and feelings with the students. There was a lively discussion on volunteer work and spirit as well.

On December 19th, Fuyang Laian Trading Company Ltd donated 200 boxes of drinks and 200 bottles of laundry detergent to the Chi Heng Foundation Fuyang office. The items will be released to the registered poor families sponsored by Chi Heng in four areas in Fuyang.



Chi Heng Releases Winter Materials in Central and Southwest China

From December 9th to 29th, three offices of Chi Heng in Central China released materials including down jackets, quilts, and oil to 929 poor families. Many people donated shoes, hats and winter coats. The materials were released before the Chinese New Year, wishing the families a warm new year.



From December 2nd to 9th, Chi Heng Yunnan office released 244 bags of rice and bottles of oil to the local registered poor families in five areas. Staff from Chi Heng visited 28 families to deliver love and support from society.

Chi Heng Interviews Vocational School Students in Central China

From November 30th to December 1st, Chi Heng Henan office interviewed 50 high school students and 21 vocational students who had applied for education funds. During the interviews, the staff asked about their family situation, problems in life, and encouraged them not to give up their studies.



On December 8th, Chi Heng Zhengzhou office interviewed 28 new applicants of vocational education funds. The interviews not only enhanced the applicants' understanding about Chi Heng, but also conveyed the ideal for extending help to more people.

Chi Heng Mini Winter Camp in Zhengzhou

On December 21st and 22nd, 20 children spent two thrilling days with 20 college students sponsored by Chi Heng during Chi Heng's mini winter camp in Zhengzhou. Jason, the department manager, showed the students both Chinese and Western style breads made by Carrefour. Carrefour bakery teachers showed the students how to use all of the equipment and taught them bakery skills. The Carrefour Foundation has provided SYB internships in the past two years.



Event of Chi Heng Vocational School Students' Project

From December 28th to 29th, Chi Heng Vocational School Students' Project Group organized a one-day tour for 7 sponsored students. In the tour, they visited Fuyang Museum and watched the movie "Chief Executive Officer". The students took the Hollander Occupation Interest Test and participated in a desert survival game.
