Chi Heng sponsorship disbursement in Yunnan

Sponsorship for students from primary schools and middle schools in Yunnan were delivered by Chi Heng from May 19th to 28 th. Chi Heng has been providing support to students in Yunnan since 2008. Some local families also received material



assistance from Chi Heng in the form of food packages. Sponsorship disbursement for this school year finished at the end of June. Over 1,400 students from over 30 villages and counties received financial aid from Chi Heng, reaching a total amount of over 800,000RMB.
