They visited the most needy families affected by HIV/AIDS, and had lunch with a grandmother and her HIV positive grandson. The Sias guest lecturer Richard, who is the founder and also the President of the Global Security Industry Alliance? took part in this activity and donated money for home renovations and furniture to very poor local families. During the visit to Chi Heng social enterprises, the teachers and students brought local handicrafts back to campus for a charity sale. They learnt sewing techniques from workers in the Chi Heng Eco-bag Workshop, and they also interacted with the local students in a Chi Heng library, and encouraged the children to study hard. The teachers and students of Sias were deeply moved by the activities, which also made the AIDS orphans feel loved and appreciated.
