## Events on World AIDS Orphan Day

### Phoenix Chinese TV interviewed with Chi Heng Foundation

On the afternoon of May 7th, World AIDS Orphan Day, Chairman of Chi Heng Foundation, Mr. Chung To, sponsored student Xiao Chao, Chi Heng staff member Xiao Ying, and two other Chi Heng-sponsored AIDS orphans were interviewed by Phoenix TV on the programme "Charities in China". They had a three-hour long discussion with the famous hostess Ms. Xu Gehui, Ministry of Health Goodwill Ambassador and singer Mr. Cai Guoqing and UNAIDS Programme Associate Mr. Guy Taylor. Mr. Chung To shared his fifteen-year experience in charity, providing detailed accounts of Chi Heng's programs on the provision of education for children impacted by AIDS in China. The other guests also talked about the present situation of HIV and shared their efforts to prevent and raise awareness on HIV. More than 40 Chi Heng volunteers attended the session.

On 12th May, mothers from Singapore, Ireland and England went to Fuyang to spend Mother's Day with AIDS orphans. These volunteers drew pictures and played games with the orphans – who in turn thanked all the volunteers by organizing special performances. These orphans did not feel lonely during this Mother's Day because of the love they received from the visitors.

On 20th May, 6 foreign guest lecturers at SIAS International School of Zhengzhou University participated in a volunteer visit. Some of them are HIV/AIDS medical experts and others are well-known social entrepreneurs. They were eager to share their own opinions on the future operation of Chi Heng's Eco-bag Project and gave advice on how to provide more training and job opportunities to AIDS-affected people.



## AIDS Candlelight Memorial Day

### Mr. To gives presentations at universities in Shandong

May 19th is the 30th AIDS Candlelight Memorial Day. Mr. Chung To was invited to give presentations in Jinan University, Shandong University and Shandong University of Finance and Economics. While introducing Chi Heng's programs, Mr. To also discussed the concept of charity with university students and called for more attention towards the situation of AIDS orphans. He encouraged students to support equality and diversity. More than 800 students attended the events.



### "Dialogue with Youths: Raising HIV/AIDS awareness and advocating for equal treatment"

On May 19th at Tsinghua University and Beijing Renmin University, The Chi Heng Beijing team organized two public forums aimed at raising awareness on HIV/AIDS and promoting equal treatment for HIV/AIDS affected groups. Students actively participated in different activities and discussions that helped them clear up myths and misconceptions surrounding HIV/AIDS. They all showed a willingness to be involved in anti-discrimination campaigns and to provide more care to the HIV/AIDS community.

### Vocational Student Interviews and Home Visits in Henan

On May 20th and 21st, Chi Heng Zhumadian team conducted family visits to reach over 40 new students and to strengthen the connection with existing students and their families. On May 25th, 13 applicants for support to vocational schooling were interviewed, through which the students learned about Chi Heng's work and its charitable goals.



## Children's Day Events

### Chi Heng sponsorship and scholarship disbursement in Henan

On May 27th, Mr. To disbursed sponsorship to 90 high school students and scholarship to 53 high school students and 151 middle school students. Chi Heng staff also prepared milk and eggs to students who would soon take their final year exams and held parties for student's upcoming birthdays. Later, Chi Heng Henan office manager Mr. Zhu Chunlei shared his own experience on final exams with the students. Schools and parents of the students presented Chi Heng with a banner as a gesture of their appreciation.



### Children's Day Activities in Anhui

On May 25th, Chi Heng Anhui team celebrated Children's Day with 18 sponsored children. 14 students from Fuyang Normal college gave them a campus tour. They made sandwiches together and watched a 3D movie. Mr. Chung To disbursed scholarship to 8 students and certificates of recognition to the volunteers. The event was supported by partner companies and encouraged students to be more positive and confident.



### Bicycle Charity Ride on Public Welfare Saturday

At 8:00 am on May 25th, Beijing Development and Promotion Center for Youth Associations, Yanqing County Youth League Committee and China Bicycle Magazine co-organized a charity ride that was aimed at raising money for AIDS orphans. The riding started at the Beijing National Stadium and attracted more than 300 cyclists. 20 riders participated in a 100-kilometer relay ride from Beijing to Yanqing.
