On October 17, our president Chung To was invited to Southwest Jiaotong University to give a keynote speech in "Youth Forum Issue 33". He sincerely shared his 15-year experience of helping AIDS orphans with about 500 students, starting with the story of Chi Heng Foundation giving back to society through AIDS orphans program, and ending with remarks on the future development of public welfare. The speech successfully spread the charity philosophy that helping other people in need will lead more people to keep charity going.

On October 30, Chi Heng Shanghai Office was invited to participate in TALK 2013 "Global Public Welfare Leaders in Innovation" held in Shanghai International Convention and Exhibition Centre. Chi Heng paid tuition fees for college students in Central China

On October 31, Chi Heng Zhengzhou Project Site carried out the work of helping college students to pay their tuition fees for the 2013-2014 school year. Chi Heng selected a total of 424 students based on five stages of interviews and the results of their financial situation assessments. All the funds were transferred directly into the students' online bank account by Chi Heng Hong Kong Financial, ensuring that special charity funds were used for chosen donatees. Tuition support will continue to be dispensed to 300 existing students and another 300 new students in this coming school year, giving warmth to them in the winter time.

Chi Heng Zhumadian Project Site carried out job interview with technical school students

On October 26-27, Chi Heng Zhumadian Project Site interviewed 32 senior technical school students who applied for support from Chi Heng over two days. In the interviews, the background and supporting standard of Chi Heng Foundation were introduced to students and their parents. Chi Heng staff contributed two internal publications to these students and encouraged them to finish their studies and overcome the difficulties in life.

"Women's Leadership in Social Enterprises" symposium held in Shanghai

On October 27, FYSE held a symposium titled "Women in Social Enterprise" in Shanghai. In the symposium, Mr. Chung To and Floriane, the project leader of Shanghai Young Bakers (SYB), made speeches respectively. Other well-known female social entrepreneurs also attended this symposium.
