The program will offer assistance to students in Heze impacted by AIDS and eliminate poverty and school drop-out resulting from the disease. It will provide a strong guarantee to those students to complete their studies, and will have a positive impact on AIDS prevention in the local area.

Mr. Chung To, interviewed 48 new higher education tuition fund applicants in Luohe and Zhengzhou in Henan province on November 6th and 17th. The interviews not only enhanced Chi Heng's understanding of the new applicants, but also conveyed its idea of extending help to more people. On November 12th, Chi Heng granted the first lot of tuition funds for autumn 2013. A total number of 549 vocational school students, including those registered in autumn 2013 and those recently interviewed, received the grant. The remaining 297 previously registered vocational school students will receive the funds in the middle of December for this semester.

Chi Heng's 2014 charity desktop calendars are available now. Thousands of calendars have been mailed out swiftly greatly assisted by the support of volunteers from Pizza Express, who spent a morning in Chi Heng Hong Kong office on November 19th. The calendars include drawings by AIDS orphans who attended the CHF Art Counselling Program. All purchases directly support the education of AIDS impacted children in China.

OSC 2013 will support Chi Heng with the "Heroes in the Mirror" program, which will adapt the well-established Hero Book program in Africa, to help psychosocial development in high school students impacted by AIDS in China. The program started in the fourth quarter of 2013 and will continue until the first quarter of 2015.

Around 20 volunteers from Fudan University, the University of Communications, HOGAN&LOVELLS and other enterprises participated in the charity sale and introduced Chi Heng's project on AIDS orphans to people at the fair. Pastries freshly baked by SYB were very popular and money was raised from the sale.



Mr. Chung To, was invited to attend the 2013 ICSF Summit - Replication and Chain Operation on November 7th. The lecture shared with the students how AIDS is transmitted and the related pathology through sections such as Dangerous Zones and Behavioural Analysis of AIDS patients. Chi Heng also participated in the NGO Charity Market held by the school in the evening.



Mr. Chung To was invited to attend the charity speech program organized by Beijing No.4 High School in the evening of November 14th. Sharing his 15 years' of personal experience in charity work and Chi Heng's efforts and ideas, he conveyed to the young audience the values of charity causes and raised their awareness.



Chi Heng Beijing Office was invited to attend the opening ceremony of the first campus volunteer program of the University of International Business and Economics on the evening of November 20th. As the only institution invited, Chi Heng delivered a speech and two of its volunteers shared with the audience their personal experiences in charity work and called for more participation from university students to volunteering in charity work. In the recent five years, Chi Heng has organized more than eight charity events in the University of International Business and Economics.



In the afternoon of November 22nd, the lecture room of Zhengzhou SIAS International University, which houses 300 people, was fully packed.
