Most importantly, the organizing committee revealed the date and location of the upcoming trip this year – November 7th to 10th at Luoyang, a rich historical and cultural city in the west of Henan Province in central China. ## Chi Heng Social Enterprise partners with Park Hyatt Beijing Hotel

In 2014, the eco-friendly bag factory of Chi Heng will cooperate with Park Hyatt Beijing Hotel in producing the supply of laundry bags and slipper bags for hotel guest rooms. The earnings will support Chi Heng AIDS orphans to go back to school. At the same time the scheme enables AIDS-impacted women in rural areas to make a living with dignity, and helps develop the rural economy.

## Chi Heng Yunnan Project held communication activities with students of NYU Shanghai

On April 5th and 6th, 9 university students sponsored by CHF Yunnan spent time with students and faculty members of NYU Shanghai. Chi Heng students introduced local cuisine to the guests and showed them places of interest. They also held a mountain climbing competition and parties. It was a meaningful cultural exchange for the two groups of students.



From April 8th to 12th, the guests from NYU Shanghai visited two libraries established by Chi Heng in the rural schools, and presented learning tools to the students. They also interacted with the students, sharing with them the joy of studying English and learning painting. The guests also visited some Chi Heng sponsored families and brought loving care to the remote, mountainous villages.

## Chi Heng Central China Project Grants Tuition Fee and Gift Bags

From April 14th to 25th, Chi Heng Central China project granted tuition fees and milk powder to primary and secondary school students in seven areas. 1,610 primary students and 1,155 secondary students received grants and 738 of them received 123 heart-to-heart gift bags, 194 normal gift bags and 26 boxes of milk powder. Those actions relieved the pressure of the disadvantaged families and encouraged the students to continue their studies.



## CHF Voluntourism Trip to Southwest China

From April 12th to 15th, CHF Voluntourism group visited Mans and Tengchong in Yunnan. Mr. Chung To acted as the tour guide and took the group members to the Mengbanaxi Exotic Park. They joined the water-sprinkling festival of the city and had a great time dancing and singing with local people. During the trip, students sponsored by Chi Heng also joined them, helping the voluntourism group better enjoy the profound and rich culture.

The classroom focused on the psychosocial development of students and encouraged their interest in learning.
