### 2014 Chi Heng College Students Summer Work Closing Meeting

The Chi Heng college students summer campaign, which lasted a whole month, ended successfully on 20th August. With 152 college student participants, the campaign managed to accomplish 5,718 home visits, as well as setting up 20 interest classes. 1,092 primary and middle school students benefited from these interest classes, which covered provinces of Henan, Anhui, Yunnan, Guangxi, Guangdong and Shandong. The Closing Meeting was held in Guilin, in which college students shared their accomplishments. The meeting was a comprehensive summary for the 2014 summer campaign, and at the same time officially opened the work for the next school year.
