## Anti-discrimination Day Thematic Activities

To commemorate the International AIDS Candlelight Memorial Day (May 17th), Chi Heng Beijing office, co-working with DHgate.com, VMware as well as Chi Heng volunteers, organized AIDS walks on May 9th, 16th and 17th respectively.
