From 18th to 20th September, 13 volunteers from Hong Kong and Canada visited Zhoukou, Henen province to celebrate the Mid Autumn Festival with 30 Chi Heng sponsored students. Presents and encouragement were given to these kids. Volunteers were sympathetic to what the kids had suffered and determined to make more appeals to peoples to care about the education of AIDS orphans.

Chi Heng x College Charity Activity

On September 18th, Chi Heng and 20 representative students from more than 10 universities in Beijing jointly organized the "Chi Heng x College Charity Activities" sharing conference. Chi Heng is planning to have more collaboration with colleges to spread the charity spirit.

Chi Heng's Volun-Online

To give company and supplementary education to AIDS orphans in remote areas of China, Chi Heng's Volun-Online project has already established 6 classrooms in the past 2 years. This year, VMware in Beijing joined and formed a volunteer teaching group. Chi Heng had a briefing session with the team on 16th September. They all look forward to the online classes that will be kicked off in mid October.

Charity Sale in the Shanghai Alley

On September 19th, Chi Heng Shanghai held a charity sale in the Jiashan market at Shanghai traditional alley. Products of Chi Oi Social Enterprise were sold for fund raising to support Chi Heng. We also got the opportunity interviewed by STV.



Home Visit in Central & South-western China

In September, the home visit team in Zhumadian visited 93 families of sponsored students in 14 counties. They also collected updated information about the families. This first hand information is vital for us to review the urgent needs of the children. We also distributed milk powder to those in need, and taught them basic knowledge in medica-

At the same time, the team in Lincang visited 114 families in 3 project areas. They celebrated the festival with the families and sent milk powder to them. 30 children, 18 parents, and 3 members from CDC spent the mid-autumn festival together. Through learning the history of mid-autumn festival, children gained more knowledge about Chinese traditional festivals. This parent-child interactive activity helped the children feel happy and warm.
