From 2nd to 4th October, two university students supported by Chi Heng were invited to join the “Unbounded Art, Priceless Beauty, Infinite Love – the 1st Hong Kong International Female Contemporary Art Exhibition” in Hong Kong. The exhibition was co-organized by Hong Kong Art of Nature International Feminist Art Research Society and INWAA and held at the low block of Hong Kong City Hall from 2nd to 8th October, 2015.
