Activities in Central China

On March 7th, Zhengzhou office organized its first girls' festival activity named "Celebrate Girl's Festival in March". Nine Chi Heng sponsored university female students took part. They presented self health management skills, make-up and dress-up skills for work in the event.



On March 27th, Zhengzhou office organized the 2016 Zhengkai Marathon "Run for Love" activity. 24 students, 15 autistic children from Zhengzhou Ruiman Recovery Center and 26 corporate volunteers joined the race together. After the race, participants played games with the children from Ruiman, in order to show their love and care. The event aims to pass on positive energy by demonstrating the concept of "one helps three, three help nine".



On March 26th, Zhengzhou office organized a 2016 alumni reunion. 12 Chi Heng sponsored university students gathered together at Zheng Zhou Bishagang Park. They performed talent shows and shared their working experiences. They got to know more about one another and improved their social skills through the reunion.



Shangcai office organized a weekend tour for 33 primary and secondary students from March 26th to 27th. They learned about life in university through visiting Xinyang Normal College. They also took part in team activities in the countryside. Through these activities, the students could feel being loved and cared and thus built up hope and confidence for the future.



In late March, Zhumadian office visited the home of 36 newly sponsored students.
