Guzheng Charity Concert Raised Funds for AIDS Orphans



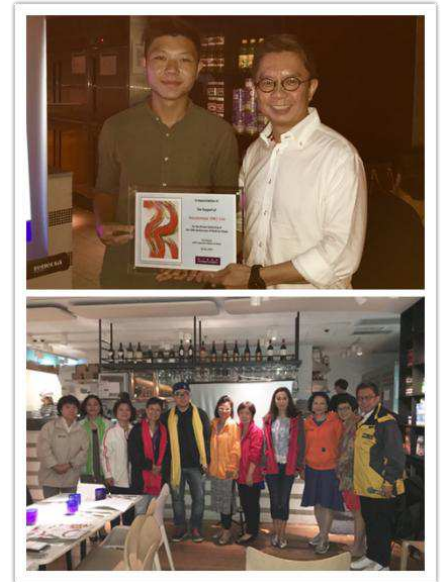

The sixth Chi Heng Academy Training was successfully held during the 2016 summer holiday. Total 195 university students joined the course and they will have the opportunity to take part in the University Students Summer Internship Program in the future. ■

University Students Summer Internship

University students who have completed the training at Chi Heng Academy are eligible for joining University Students Summer Internship. During the summer holidays, they work as interns at Chi Heng and contribute to society.

In the 2016 Summer Internship, a total of 252 university students worked as summer interns in different areas. Work duties included home visits, data management, organizing activity and interest groups. Throughout their internship, they have completed home visits for total 4899 sponsored children. Besides, 36 interest classes were conducted and 98 activities were arranged in which about 2900 sponsored children were benefited.

At the same time, some university students led the children to visit elderly homes. They chatted with the elderly, did performances and helped do the cleaning. The elderly loved them so much! ■

Summer Camps

Every year, in July and August, Chi Heng organizes summer camps in different cities of China. The aim is to give the sponsored children opportunities to visit and learn in the big cities so as to help them develop their potential and set their future goals.

Although the summer camps have different itineraries, all the camps serve the same goal of helping students to have better development in the following four domains:

1. **Academic development:** have a better understanding of their study paths through university visits.
2. **Career orientation:** know more about different industries and workplaces through enterprise visits.
3. **Psycho-social counselling:** learn how to express their feelings and emotions through different art workshops such as painting, music and dancing.
4. **Horizon broadening:** widen their horizons through visiting different scenic spots, museums and historic sites.

This year, apart from the summer camps in Beijing, Shanghai and Guangzhou, with the full support from generous donors, two more summer camps were organized in Hangzhou. Together with those regional camps held in Zhoukou, Zhengzhou, Zhumadian and Guangxi, more than 500 children benefited from the summer camps.

Apart from visits and tours, we also organized some educational activities. For example, in Guangxi Beihai Summer Camp, students learnt about the conservation and exploration of mangroves as well as knowledge about disaster reduction and disaster preparedness work. Each student was also given a emergency relief pack for future use.

After each activity, we collected questionnaires from students for record keeping, analysis and evaluation purposes so that we can improve our future programmes. To sum up, the biggest benefit students got from the summer camps was friendship and they made many new friends. Having left home for a few days, students became more independent and their thinking capacity was enhanced too. They also learnt how to take care of others.
