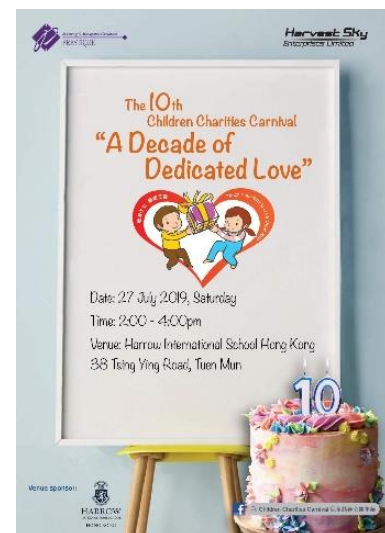


Children Charities Carnival 2019
