

In mid-March, Ms. Xiaoling TONG, the Chinese Consul General in Vancouver, met Chung TO, Founder, Chi Heng Foundation, and Evelyn CHENG, the Vice President of Chi Heng Foundation Canada. Chung presented to the Consul General Chi Heng's effort of the past 21 years: bringing together the support from everywhere to provide HIV prevention for vulnerable groups in Mainland China, providing financial support for AIDS patients and their children, and providing psychological counselling, vocational training, and family self-reliance.
